In2MedSchool is a widening participation initiative that consists of a group of medical students and junior doctors helping underprivileged school children apply to study Medicine and related subjects at University.

Schools Engagement Programme

The SEP is a brand new programme that we are launching in September 2023. Through visiting schools, colleges and sixth forms we can engage with students from a diverse range of backgrounds to empower and inspire them to consider a career as a doctor. We aim to provide pupils, parents and staff with necessary support and guidance to navigate the complex and competitive process of applying to Medicine.



Role Responsibilities

- To oversee the organisation of in-person and virtual events at specific schools, including liaising with the Events, Media and Academia teams as needed.
- To meet monthly with the appropriate Schools' Engagement Directors(s) to provide an update on the region's progress.
- Escalate concerns to the appropriate Schools' Engagement Director.
- Cultivate partnerships with local schools, making sure they are aware of In2MedSchool's offer and how we can support them.
- To oversee communication with schools across their region that approach them for collaborations (events or otherwise)
- To facilitate and attend the in-person and virtual events at schools to inform them about the offers of In2MedSchool and the process of applying to Medicine.
- To assist in creating academic resources for school visits specific to their region.
- Be motivated to meet the suggested target of organising one school visit every 2 weeks.
- Be flexible with the number of hours volunteering per week depending on personal/academic timetable and the opportunities available to conduct visits.



Requirements

• Essential:

- Must have held a role with In2MedSchool.
- UK based applicant with experience or sound knowledge of the A Level system
- Desire to contribute to the expansion of widening participation in Medicine nationally.
- Willingness to approach schools, charities, or individuals across the UK to establish collaborations.
- Willingness to travel up to 40 miles maximum distance to attend school visits (cost of travel to be reimbursed).
- Enthusiastic about speaking to groups of students and staff about applying to Medicine and careers in the healthcare sector.

• Desirable:

- Have access to a car/have a driving license to be able to travel to visits.
- Have contacts/communications with local schools to organise visits.
- Previous experience of delivering presentations
- Previous experience working with schools, colleges, sixth forms.
- Previous experience in leadership roles.
- Previous experience working within a team.
